



John Bell's theory of non-locality concludes that even God is bound by the Uncertainty Principle (Wikipedia). From this scientists concluded that that which shapes the Universe is not deterministic, it is free will. At a recent check, 178 scholarly articles cited works that prove the Kochen-Specker theorem. But 110 articles cited works in which measurement disproves the Kochen-Specker theorem. Personally I love it. To me it means that indeterminacy cannot be determined. It is a matter of faith! In Nisience, we see the Coinciding Principle as an evidence of mediation from the spiritual worlds. Carl Jung explained coincidences using what he called the "acausal connecting principle" or synchronicity – a pattern of connections that cannot be explained by causality.

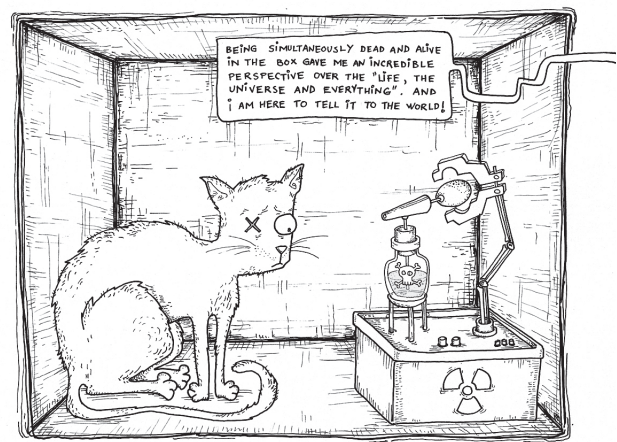
*A well-known example of synchronicity involves plum pudding. It is the true story of the French writer Emile Deschamps who in 1805 is treated to some plum pudding by the stranger Monsieur de Fontgibu. Ten years later, he encounters plum pudding on the menu of a Paris restaurant, and wants to order some, but the waiter tells him the last dish has already been served to another customer, who turns out to be M. de Fontgibu. Many years later in 1832 Emile Deschamps is at a dinner, and is once again offered plum pudding. He recalls the earlier incident and tells his friends that only M. de Fontgibu is missing to make the setting complete, and in the same instant the now senile M. de Fontgibu enters the room by mistake.*<sup>3</sup>

Because synchronicity is not testable, science does not believe it can yield hard facts. Those who study coincidences say science can deal only with reproducible events that are independent of observers. By definition, synchronicity is a function of the observer. Science cannot dismiss it, however, because quantum theory is also connected with the observer. Quantum theory complicates the matter.

Let's assume that everyone is familiar with the wave-matter duality of quantum mechanics so we can jump ahead to Schrödinger's Cat. In a famous thought experiment, the developers of quantum mechanics put a cat in a box with a capsule of cyanide. One variation has a particle shot at a double opening in the box. As a wave it passes through both gates at once. As a particle it can only pass through one. Only one of the two gates triggers the breaking of the cyanide capsule. The question is asked, "Is the cat alive or

dead?" The quantum reality of the cat says it is both. The wave function collapses to a discrete outcome only when observation takes place. So the cat's fate exists as both realities until someone looks.

In Copenhagen, the founders of quantum mechanics stated the orthodox view that everything has only a probability of existence until it is measured or observed. Observation collapses the wave possibilities into material outcomes. So quantum functions are possibilities. When people make choices, they form the boundaries to their future options. In a sense, they form the future they will experience. The act of choosing or observing sets the boundaries around a person's various future possibilities.

A classic joke running around school from time to time is whether hell is exothermic or endothermic. The answer usually involves a nerd who gets a date and comments that hell has frozen over. But it's the wrong question. In Dante's *Inferno*, at the bottom of hell, the devil is suspended head-

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first in a lake of ice. The Third Law of Thermodynamics defines the state of zero entropy as a perfect crystal frozen at the coldest possible temperature, zero Kelvin. This is the bottom of the Universe – zero degrees of freedom – only one possible state of existence. Dante describes this state through the mythic literary consciousness. The devil’s zero degrees of freedom are the ultimate hell – trapped forever without the possibility of change. Hell is not endothermic or exothermic, but hell is rather the state of zero entropy.

Reading in both science and scriptures, one finds what corresponds with science expressed through the mythic symbologies of former days. So the best minds of any age tell their stories through the medium of their day. Science, religion, and philosophy tell the same story.

A student once shared a vivid dream with me. He said that while he was dreaming he knew it was exactly 18 years into the future. He was observing masses of people. Around their hearts was an all white glowing nimbus. He shared that he had seen this in dreams before, but previously each person had individualized colors. In the year 2030, he looked at the factory that was producing clone-like beings that were all identical. Over the factory hung a sign with one word: “Choiceless.” Zero degrees of freedom.

How does one interpret such a dream? It depends on your horizon. You have to answer the three classic questions: Who am I? Where did I come from? Where am I going? Are you a deterministic piece of flesh controlled by genes and environment, a consumer in a mechanized world? Or are you something more than material? Is consciousness just the froth bubbling up from brain chemistry? Or is there something more operating behind the observable limit? Can science even answer this question?

Beyond the quantum veil is nothing – or else everything: the potentiality of Spirit yet to manifest. Ann Ree spoke of Ptolemy’s Third Heaven as a world of Archetypes – blueprints yet to take form. Some things are only observable through faith. These things are not generally repeatable upon demand. Like synchronicity, they are acausal. A question of faith can’t be settled by research. But it’s simple to a child. A child can see it. If you ask me as a scientist I have to say that I do not know. But I have seen. I know. And for me, what I’ve seen confirms what others have seen. Is it verifiable? Only through the eyes of faith. Does this disprove it? In a universe of indeterminacy, I would have to say no. It is a mystery.

Ann Ree spoke of proving God, but there’s a paradox here. You can’t actually prove God to others, and that is a good thing. God uses the honor system of faith. You can mark and trace and prove Him only through your own confirming process.

To the unenlightened, what one believes to be true appears to be true. So how can anything be proven true. Were God to be scientifically provable, then the Universe would have to be pre-determined – and you would have no free will. Without free will, how could you choose the learning you need to become “like Jesus?” So God chooses to be behind the observable or quantum veil, and we have freedom.

A person can rail, “If there is a God, why does He allow so much evil and suffering in the world?” But it is not a true question. One must see the perfection of divine justice. The Law doesn’t prove God, but the Law reveals God to the seeker. Maya is tricky. Its energy units function according to Law, but you can interpret cause and effect as you wish.
